Sample Itinerary:

Day 1: Travel to upstate New York. **NOTE: TRAVEL THROUGH CANADA AND PROPER ID REQUIRED—PASSPORT OR ENHANCED DRIVER'S LICENSE. MUST BE A MICHIGAN ENHANCED LICENSE.**
